


LAW ENFORCEMENT CAREER STATISTICS

TYPICAL DEPARTMENT RANK DISTRIBUTION




Average staffing ratios in U.S. municipal police departments

MUNICIPAL POLICE DEPARTMENT RANKS

SHERIFF'S OFFICE RANKS

Sheriff's offices serve county jurisdictions and are typically headed by an elected sheriff. They often include law enforcement, jail operations, and court security responsibilities. View our <u>sheriff badges</u> collection.

STATE POLICE / HIGHWAY PATROL RANKS

State police agencies have statewide jurisdiction and often use military-style rank structures. They focus on highway patrol, criminal investigations, and assisting local agencies.
